

**Alberto Múnera, S.J.** is PhD in Philosophy and Literature, Universidad Javeriana, Bogotá; STD in Moral Theology, Università Gregoriana, Rome. He has been Director of undergraduate Programs at the School of Theology, Jesuit Javeriana University of Bogotá. He is former Dean of the School of Theology, of the School of Education and of the Graduate School for Interdisciplinary Studies in the same University, and former Director of the Institute for Social and Cultural Studies “Pensar”. He has been Professor of Moral Theology during more than 40 years. He was elected three times Vice-President and two times President of the World Conference of Catholic Theological Institutions.
