Rev. Dr. Maria Michael Peters, C.P.P.S, born in Bangalore, India, on 23rd Feb. 1964. He belongs to the Congregation of Missionaries of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus Christ, known as Precious Blood Missionaries. He was ordained as Priest by St. John Paul II on 26th May 1991 at Vatican, in St. Peter's Basilica. He completed his STL in Moral Theology at the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Urbe – (Angelicum) Rome – 1992. He was Mission director for his Congregation in India from 1992 to 1996. He is also a visiting Professor in Moral Theology and teaches other theological subjects in various Religious Institutes. He has a diploma in Inter-religious Dialogue, given at Jerusalem by SHALOM HARTMAN INSTITUTE and he was awarded with a Certificate of Recognition for specific studies in in the Inter-religious Dialogue by Russell Berrie Fellows, through INSTITUTE OF INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION – Hungary - Budapest. He completed his Doctorate in Moral Theology in Angelicum at Rome in 2011. He is a well-known retreat preacher. He is a Councillor and Confessor. He has published books on "Feminine Spirituality" - titled – “Behold Woman”. Later he published "INWARD JOURNEY" on meditation and "Living Together - With Him Always" on Religious life. Another book of his is “Let’s Worship the Lord” which speaks about the Divine Worship and its importance. He also published several articles in various journals such as New Horizon, Gender Justice in the Church And Society, a Dharmaram Moral Theology Series, No. 3, etc. He also wrote Reviews on "Family Catechesis" which is basic text for Catechism school children of the Archdiocese of Goa and Daman. He also worked in the CCBI as National Executive Secretary for Family Commission.
