**2. Title.**

Ética teológica en diálogo interdisciplinario

**3. General description**

The aim of this VT is to establish a space for dialogue, discernment, and academic trainee from a Latin American and Caribbean perspective, in theological ethics reflection. This initiative is not intended to dismiss the work of recognized theologians and ethicists in these areas, but rather to broaden the spectrum of voices, in particularly emerging voices (those who are taking their first steps on this path), providing the opportunity to express themselves in the theological field or through related disciplines. The goal of this initiative is to encourage and support these new leaders voices, and propose alternative approaches to reflect on new areas of social and ecclesial action from the Latin American and Caribbean reality.

**5. Purpose of the proposed virtual table**

- Principal

Generate a safe space for dialogue, reflection, training and production around ethical-theological themes from a LATAM&C perspective.

- Specifics

Generate spaces for synchronic and asynchronic dialogue and training  
Establish common criterias (categories, methodologies, etc.) to develop individual and community work.

To share the conclusions obtained in works and/or common actions and in other types of instances (publications, collaborative works, webinars, etc.)

## **6. Reporting methodology of the proposed virtual table**

To write a report after each activity we carry out, addressed to the academic coordinator of our region (Prof. Ma. Isabel Gil Espinosa).

## **7. Call to members**

The VT will begin its activity with their initial members (see profiles in point 1) and subsequently the call will be opened for those people interested in participating in a space dedicated to carry out a first approach to theological ethics reflection, in an interdisciplinary approach and with a perspective rooted in the Latin American and Caribbean reality.

## **8. Frequency of meetings**

Periodical meetings (bimonthly).

Internal training seminar (between two and three per year).
